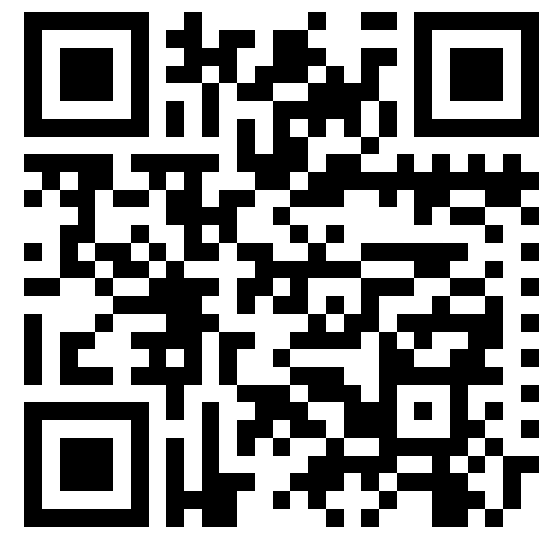

## Work-Based Learning Opportunities for Academic year 2021/22

Foundation Apprenticeships are available at SCQF Levels 4, 5 and 6 and provide school pupils with real experience of the world of work within Scotland's growth industries of the Visitor Economy, STEM and Construction.

The opportunities are available to study for a Foundation Apprenticeships in 2021/22 which support young people to gain industry knowledge and experience whilst they are still in school. Foundation Apprenticeships are offered across several subject areas and SCQF levels enabling the creation and development of career pathways.

## Choose these Foundation Apprenticeships as part of your subject choice in S4-S6



These subjects are all available at SCQF L4, Hospitality is also available at SCQF L5, which is the same level of learning as National 4 and 5 qualifications. These qualifications include a Work Based Challenge Unit where you will work closely with an employer on a real life project to develop understanding of the industry and to develop some of the highly valued meta skills such as: communication, creativity and decision making. Pupils should be ready and able to study and achieve at SCQF level 4/5.

## Choose these Foundation Apprenticeships as part of your subject choice in S5-S6



These subjects are all available at SCQF L6, which is the same level of learning as a Higher qualification. Foundation Apprenticeships provide an opportunity to gain valuable industry experience and an industry recognised qualification that supports future pathways into College, Employment, Modern Apprenticeships and University. They also let you try out a career whilst still at school. Work Experience will take place with a combination of physical attendance and on-line delivery and provide young people with experience of current work-place practice.

Foundation Apprenticeship programmes will begin in the 2021 academic year, some programmes will start their induction in June. Young people interested in selecting a Foundation Apprenticeship should discuss this further with school guidance and should be ready and able to study and achieve at SCQF Level 6.
